Dalen Hotel is one of Norway's most iconic and historic hotels, often referred to as the "fairytale hotel" due to its romantic architecture and enchanting atmosphere. Built in 1894, the hotel is a masterpiece of the Swiss chalet style with strong influences of the national romantic style, characterized by ornate wooden carvings, dragonhead decorations, towers, turrets, and balconies. It is located at the end of the Telemark Canal, nestled between lush forests and steep mountains.

Historical Significance

Originally opened to host European royalty and aristocrats traveling through Norway, Dalen Hotel quickly became a symbol of luxury in Scandinavia. Over the years, it has hosted kings, queens, and notable dignitaries from across Europe. It was restored in the 1990s to preserve its unique charm and is now considered one of Norway's most culturally significant hotels.
